**GUIDELINE & FORM FOR LEAVING YOUR LOVE ONE’S ASHES
AND/OR MEMORIAL PICTURE AT PHÁP-QUANG TEMPLE**

Dear followers,

Below are rules and guideline for leaving ashes and/or memorial pictures at Phap-Quang (PQ) Temple, please help the Temple with the following items:

I. Ashes Urn (Due to health issue, the Temple only accept ashes from cremation):

1. Urn size w7 x h9 ½ x d7 inches or smaller, there are self-degraded in sea water also available.
2. For each ash urn, the minium initiation fee payable to Phap-Quang Temple is \$500(*), the temple will have build-in of cabinet space for ash urn in the back room of QALV.
3. The maximum period for Phap Quang temple to keep the urn of ashes is 10 years, after 10 years those ashes shall be scattering at Galveston Bay, we are in the processed of organizing the trip from charting a vent to renting a boat to have the Ashes Scattering Ceremony in the near future.

II. Memorial Picture for Altar:

1. Memorial picture for altar should fit frame size 3.5”x5”, PQ Temple will provided the frame.
 2. For those with love one, whom just entered final rest, by 7th week, please provide smaller size picture for the altar that would fit for picture frame size stated above
- Phap-Quang Temple will ONLY accept ash urn and/or memorial picture in size specified above.
 - For each family with Ashes Urn & Memorial Picture, or just Memorial Picture, a maintenance fee for accent, candle and electricity is \$15 per month minimum, which can be paid in full once per year or two payments, which are due on the 1st of January and June.
 - Please fill in your contact and your love one info below. **Only the family name below can request for the picture or urn to be removed from the temple by complete the “URN OF ASHES AND/OR MEMORIAL PICTURE REMOVAL FROM PHAP-QUANG TEMPLE” form, please contact head abbot at least 2 weeks in advance.**
